- How big or small can our team be? What about ratio?
 - ► Teams can be as small as one (1) youth and as large as ten (10) youth while in the virtual environment
 - ► There will not be a chaperone to youth ratio requirement for 2021, however, every youth team must have a Team Adult Advisor present
- Is there any material available to share with school leadership about Spring Youth Forum?
